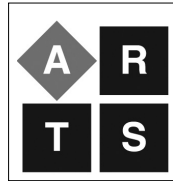

2021 Arts Citizens of the Year

David Walden and Gaynella McGuire

Since 2004 the Arts Commission has annually selected and honored individuals who have contributed to the arts in a variety of ways.

Gaynella “Gay” McGuire was selected for her behind the scenes focus on art in the schools. She is also a working artist.

Several years ago, the Wilderness Trace Art League operated an art gallery in Constitution Square. When the League decided to close the gallery, funds remaining in the gallery treasury were transferred to the Arts Commission with the stipulation that the proceeds of the investment be designated for scholarships for graduating seniors.

Gay discussed this program with the Arts Commission. She believed the money could be put to better use every year. With her leadership, the funds were freed from restriction and now are distributed annually to high school art programs for the express purpose of expanding opportunities and special projects. This year, Danville High School received money for a specialized ceramics unit and Boyle County High School will be creating a fabric sculpture for their new

performing arts space lobby.

David Walden is the owner of the Walden Funeral Home in Perryville. After years of work in the manufacturing field, he decided he wanted to do something more meaningful in the community. This decision led him to this area and his current profession.

While David himself is not an artist, he has filled his home and business with original works of art by local artists. He attends and participates in many art functions and activities, having served on the Board of the Arts Commission and has sponsored

art exhibits at the funeral home and art activities for children in Perryville.

David feels that the beauty of art is comforting to families and those who are in need of comfort.
