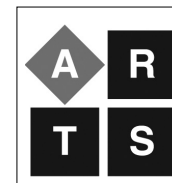

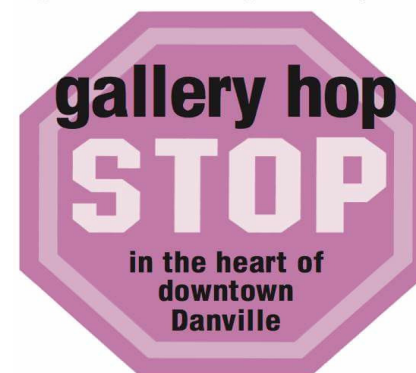

We appreciate the support of the City of Danville and the Housing Authority in presenting this event to the community.



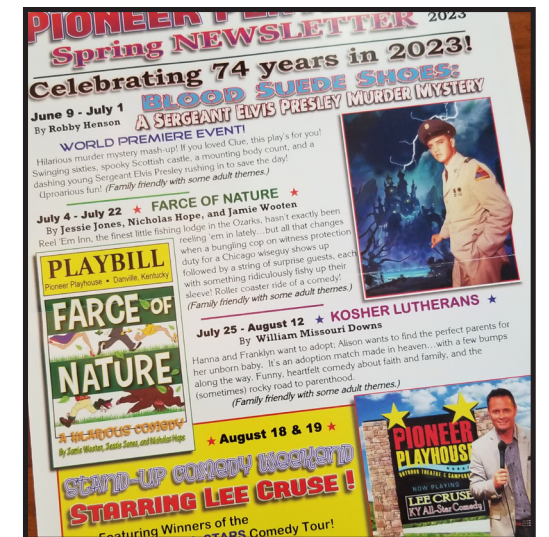
Pioneer Playhouse opens 74th season under the stars
