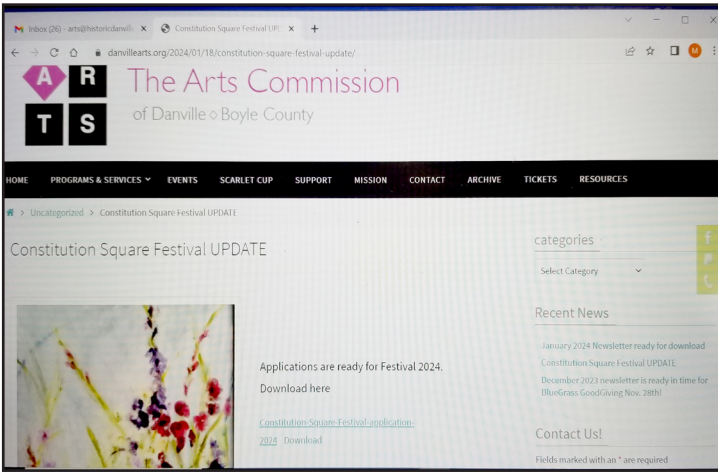


The 2023 Arts Citizen of the Year and Organization Recognition is now part of history

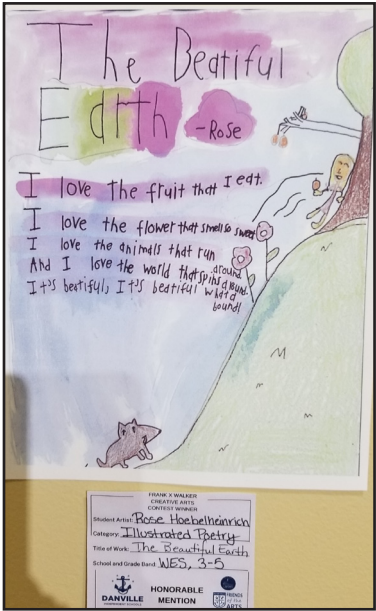
